## EXTENTRIX SAFETY ACTIVEX FOR CITRIX WEB INTERFACE

### INTRODUCTION

Extentrix Safety ActiveX tool helps administrators to rest assure that the company sensitive data are swapped out after the users' access the corporate data remotely from internet cafés or kiosk. Since remote users use Citrix web interface to access

XenApp server through a standard browser, their data will be saved by the browser to the client machine. This data is company confidential information which should not be seen or used by other people. This happens because of how the browser works to speed up internet navigation process. Extentrix Safety ActiveX upon user logging out, will start to clean client machine from any left behind information such as deleting history, all internet files, cookies. The integration of this package with the web interface html page is as simple as adding few lines to web interface html page as we will explain in the following section.

### HOW TO INTEGRATE EXTENTRIX ACTIVEX WITH CITRIX WEB INTERFACE

To do the integration follow the steps below:

1. Open *login.aspx* file which is located in the web interface folder.  
e.g.: C:\inetpub\wwwroot\Citrix\AccessPlatForm\Auth\login.aspx
  - Find the line: `<wi:Layout id="layout" runat="server" />`
  - Add **the following lines after** it:

2. Open *loggedout.aspx* file which is located in the web interface folder.  
e.g.: C:\inetpub\wwwroot\Citrix\AccessPlatForm\Auth\logout.aspx
  - Find the line : `<wi:Layout id="layout" runat="server" />`

- Add **the following lines before** it:

<BODY id=ActiveX onload="ExtentrixSafety.doDeleteAll();">

CLASSID="clsid:cfc5581f-fdcc-4915-8e50-e92bb4f11b34"

TYPE="application/x-oleobject">  
  
</OBJECT>
```

#### Notes:

- You have to change the IP address in the "CODEBASE" to your own.
- ExtentrixSafety object supports 4 different cleanup methods which can be used instead of doDeleteAll method. Refer to next section for more information.
- ClassID for Trial version (71E5A0D5-879F-45B2-BFE5-75012D58C1D2 )
- ClassID for License version (CFC5581F-FDCC-4915-8E50-E92BB4F11B34)

## EXTENTRIX SAFETY ACTIVEX DELETE METHODS

Extentrix Safety ActiveX provides 4 different delete methods for administrator convenience. They can be invoked in the same way as we showed how to invoke **doDeleteAll** method in the example in the above section. You can invoke more than one method, for example **you can invoke deleteTemp** and **deleteHistory** methods with out the need to invoke deleteCookies method. The 4 methods are listed and explained below:

- **doDeleteAll**: Deletes History data, Cookies and Temporary Internet files.
- **deleteTemp**: Deletes all Temporary Internet files.
- **deleteCookies**: Deletes all Cookies.
- **deleteHistory**: Deletes all History.
