The Extentrix Toolbar integrates Citrix® XenApp™ into the SAP portal environment, making it fast, simple and easy to access applications through the portal.



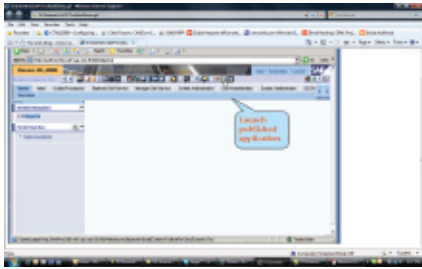
The Extentrix Toolbar for Citrix is certified for SAP NetWeaver Portal 7.0 and Citrix Ready™. The toolbar lists all applications delivered by Citrix XenApp that the user is permitted to access. Just click the appropriate icon for the desired application and it will launch. And single sign-on technology allows users to automatically log in to Citrix when logging in to the portal. The Extentrix Toolbar doesn't take up much space. The toolbar also allows users to specify the number of icons to be shown at one time and use forward and back arrows to scroll through the complete list of applications. In addition, its design will take on the familiar look and feel of your corporate portal.

How it works

The Extentrix Toolbar is based upon the iView plug-in concept so it is easy to integrate with SAP NetWeaver Portal. The toolbar connects to Extentrix Web Services – Application Edition, which provides a suite of Web services APIs that communicate with Citrix XenApp. The toolbar connects to the Citrix XenApp environment by invoking these Web services APIs.
